







<b>Title/Subject:</b> Funding of Keighley DVS and Jyoti Project 2017/18
<b>Reference:</b> MoJ Victims Support Services Fund 2017/18
<b>Executive Summary:</b> On devolution of some victim services by the Ministry of Justice, the PCC has agreed annually to continue to fund Keighley Domestic Violence Service and the Jyoti Project based with Bradford Rape Crisis. The current agreement is due to end on 31 March 2017.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> That the PCC agrees to continue to fund both Keighley Domestic Violence Service (£100,118) and the Jyoti Project (£45,000) based with Bradford Rape Crisis for a further year, to end on 31 March 2018.
