




<b>Title/Subject: Funding for resources to promote and launch the UK Modern Slavery Helpline across the West Yorkshire region.</b>

<p><b>Executive Summary:</b> To improve the quantity, quality and consistency of gathering and utilising intelligence relating to human trafficking and modern slavery across West Yorkshire and provide one method of reporting for members of the public, local businesses, statutory and non-statutory agencies thereby reducing the need for additional resources and systems it is proposed to make greater use of the UK Modern Slavery Helpline.</p> <p>The UK Modern Slavery Helpline, operates 24/7 with fully trained specialist staff who provide bespoke support as well as gathering information and intelligence on modern slavery and human trafficking.</p> <p>Funding materials to promote the use of the helpline across West Yorkshire is vital to the success of this strategy. To gain maximum impact and coverage it is aimed to have a formal launch of this innovative partnership approach on the annual United Nations World Day Against Trafficking in Persons, 30<sup>th</sup> July 2017</p>
<p><b>Requested Decision:</b></p> <p><b>The West Yorkshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner agrees to fund the materials and associated costs in relation to the promotion of the UK Modern Slavery Helpline across West Yorkshire to the amount of £1,818 from partnership monies.</b></p>
