The pupils are tasked with working in groups to develop some cyber protection advice and guidance for others using whichever media/means they choose. This could be a website, app, leaflet, rap or spoken message and can be carried out in any relevant subject area. Each school will be invited to put one entry forward from each year group. Entries will be judged in year group categories by cyber representatives from the West Yorkshire police and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner and finalists will be invited to a grand final event at West Yorkshire Police Training and Development Centre, Carr Gate, Wakefield. Finalists will present their project to a judging panel where the overall winner will be decided. First prize winners from each age range will receive a trophy and certificates, and will be treated to a tour of West Yorkshire Police's Specialist Operations site.
