- 1) Are senior officers of West Yorkshire police provided with a vehicle for their own use, both personal & business related?
- 2) If so, how much is the annual cost of this?
- 3) How many officers within West Yorkshire police could now be pensioned off, but have been allowed to remain in post?

Up until 22 November 2012, the Police Authority appointed Command Team Members; Assistant Chief Constables, the Deputy Chief Constable and the Chief Constable. The Police Authority determined the pay and conditions of those ranks in accordance with police regulations.

After 22 November 2012, when the Police Authority was abolished, the Police & Crime Commissioner became responsible for appointing the Chief Constable and determining his (her) terms and conditions. The Chief Constable is now responsible for the other Command Team Member's terms and conditions.

- 1) The Police Authority provided a car to Command Team Members for business and personal use.
- The Police & Crime Commissioner has agreed to provide a suitable fleet vehicle to the Chief Constable, for business and personal use.
- 3) The Office of the Police & Crime Commissioner does not hold information relating to the annual cost of providing vehicles, I have transferred this request to West Yorkshire Police who may hold the information you require.
- 4) The Office of the Police & Crime Commissioner does not hold the information you request. I have transferred your request to West Yorkshire Police who may hold the information you require.
