Extension of funding by 50% of the West Yorkshire ISVA Service to Victim Support to enable increased ISVA capacity

Executive Summary:		
The West Yorkshire ISVA Service requires additional capacity to ensure all victims receive support. This service for the first time provides support to all victims across West Yorkshire and including historic victims.		
Data provides evidence of large increase in volume of sexual violence crimes. In addition to this the Force is being proactive in dealing with historic cases. Subsequently there has been demand over and above that anticipated when the original service specification and procurements were undertaken.		
Requested Decision:		
The West Yorkshire ISVA Service receives an additional £50,000 for 2015/16 and an additional £100,000 for 2016/17 to enable the service to respond to increased number of victims seeking support.
