Resourcing the next stage in the development of restorative justice services in West Yorkshire

## **Executive Summary:**

This decision concerns proposals for spend on restorative practice and restorative justice in 2015/16. These are in line with the proposals in the Delivery Plan for Victim Support Services, updated August 2015. A total of £2,501,439 is available with an indicative allocation (not ringfenced) of £507,022 for restorative justice.

## Requested Decision:

To allocate the available funding as follows:

- a) West Yorkshire Co-ordination: £49.5k to be offered for West Yorkshire coordination, advice and training, seeking quotes from 3 suppliers including advertising on Bluelight
- b) Local capacity building and delivery: the remaining funding available to be split between the five districts using the same formula as for the community safety fund, resulting in the following allocations:
