**SUBJECT OF ADVICE:** Positive Futures projects change of name to *West Yorkshire Positive Futures* 

**Summary:** The Police and Crime Commissioner for West Yorkshire passed part of his Community Safety Fund to the four Positive Futures projects in West Yorkshire. The four projects are:

- Positive Futures, Bradford South Bradford Council
- Positive Futures, Calderdale Lifeline, Young People's Service
- Positive Futures, Keighley JAMES (Bradford charity)
- Positive Futures, Leeds Leeds Council

From 1 April 2013 the Home Office Positive Futures projects come to end. In the past all four projects received support and management services from Catch 22 working on behalf of the Home Office. The quotation cost for this service to continue for 2013/14 was £60,000. This amount did not form part of the monies granted from the PCC Community Safety Fund, instead the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner will support and performance manage the four projects.

The projects are no longer able to call themselves Positive Futures but are permitted to collectively use the name West Yorkshire Positive Futures.

**Recommendation:** The Commissioner agrees that the four projects previously run as Positive Futures with support from Catch 22 change their name to the collective title of *West Yorkshire Positive Futures*.

**Consideration**: Each project is in favour of the name change. There are no other considerations towards this decision.

**Affordability:** There are no financial implications for the Commissioner, force or the OPCC in terms of loss or gain.

**Supporting and dissenting Views:** All four projects are in favour of the name change.
