

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI Act).

You have requested information relating to contract 2017/S 227-473124 'Breakdown and recovery services for motor vehicles'.

Under the FOI Act you have the right to be informed if the information is held by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) and the right to be provided with the information subject to certain exemptions. I can advise you that this framework contract has not yet been awarded and is still in the evaluation stage, information is not held, therefore, in relation to your first request: suppliers who applied for the contract and were successful and unsuccessful.

On conclusion of the procurement process further information will be published about the successful bidder and the contract awarded via the Bluelight procurement database (<https://bluelight.eu-supply.com>).

Information relating to the contract value, duration of contract and renewal is already available via the link above and is therefore exempt by way of Section 21 'Information reasonably accessible by other means'. This is an absolute exemption which does not require a public interest test.
