Title/Subject: Appointment of Legally Qualified Chairs

Serial No: DP0174

Summary:

The Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) is obliged, by virtue of the Police (Conduct) Regulations 2020, to appoint Legally Qualified Chairs (LQCs) to a list and to appoint chairs to police misconduct hearings.

In 2015, the PCC agreed to collaborate regionally with the PCCs in North Yorkshire, Humberside, South Yorkshire, Durham, Cleveland and Northumbria to appoint and manage LQCs for police misconduct hearings. The terms of appointment expire on 31/12/2020.

Agreement is sought to continue this collaboration and to engage in a recruitment campaign, which is to be managed by Northumbria OPCC, including financial contribution to the cost of advertising and training (approximately £2,600).

Requested Decision: To continue to collaborate regionally to appoint Legally Qualified Chairs to a joint list, including joint training, induction and to joint list arrangements.
