





Title/Subject: Chief Officer post-employment approval
Serial No: DP0096
Summary: <p>The PCC agreed to adopt the Home Office recommendation to require the Chief Constable to notify him of any proposed post-service employment (including voluntary work) for a period of 12 months after leaving the police service. The Home Office recommended that this be effective for all Chief Constable appointments after 1 January 2018. Former Chief Constable Collins also voluntarily agreed to comply with this requirement on her retirement.</p> <p>Former Chief Constable Collins has submitted a request for approval. The request relates to voluntary work as Secretary to support the British Association of Women in Policing (BAWP).</p>
Requested Decision: <p>That the PCC approves the request for post-service unpaid employment by former Chief Constable Dee Collins.</p>
