Stop Hate	Development and launch of a Hate Crime reporting App which can be down loaded free of charge. West Yorkshire wide resource providing users with information which links to partner agencies. Media launch event	
Stop Hate	Project targets professionals working with victims of hate crime and people living with mental illness. Includes training, information/advice/guidance, resource for professionals, multiagency meetings	
Equity Partnership	WY survey among trans men and women followed by 6 workshops to identify frequency, nature and whereabouts of hate incidents. Regional conference to disseminate findings	8496
Together Women	Proactive approach through the Leeds and Bradford Together Women projects registering as women only reporting centres. 1:1 support will be provided/peer support in a safe place to share experiences and reducing risk of further isolation. Will also look at RJ approaches through cultural awareness groups to hate crimes. Peer mentors.	8176.5
Bradford Hate Crime Alliance	Conduct a survey to gauge the sentiments of Muslim and non-Muslim relationships with regards to anti-Muslim hate and Islamaphobia; Provide date to local authority and WYP to enable strategy development. Survey will be community led using trained volunteers. Sample size 800	15000
Safe Places	Development of Apps to provide comfort to victims that help is only a 'push of a button away'. Support victims to have the confidence to access their community without fear of becoming a victim of hate crime.	4300
Leeds City Council	Working together to promote a zero tolerance approach and seek to develop new HIRC's within Faith Centres to counteract known cultural barriers to reporting faith related hate incidents and provide safe routes into services.	
Kirklees Council	Creation of a smartphone App which will be easy to use and contain key information and advice around hate crime - how to identify and report it.	1500
Leeds Gypsy and Traveller Exchange	Produce, design and print a resource pack which will seek to inform agencies of the issues gypsies and travellers face with hate crime. Organise a conference to launch.	9037
Wakefield Council	Free from Hate project. Addressing under reporting of hate crime - support victim - deliver activities with the aim of people and communities being free from fear. Training sessions/awareness sessions/youth outreach/support group for young people, Muslim women/workshops for Muslim women/young people LGBT group. Produce a video to distribution to young people online via schools.
