| Executive Summary: In December 2014 the West Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC) Partnership Executive Group (PEG) Innovation sub-group made a series of proposals to address issues in relation to Child sexual Exploitation which had been identified by the West Yorkshire Directors of Children's Services (DCS's) and the West Yorkshire CSE Strategy Group. This project was delivered through a grant agreement with Calderdale Council The grant agreement and proposal allocated £385k for year 1 and £297k for year 2. Part of the grant agreement was for development of information and data sharing across West Yorkshire. Requested Decision: The West Yorkshire OPCC approves the recommendations in the supporting paper to provide funding for 2 years for the creation of a centrally located CSE and missing data analyst, to improve information and data sharing in relation to CSE and missing children across the 5 districts of West Yorkshire and partners and to develop a partnership problem profile for CSE, missing children and children missing education. | | |
