	Executive Summary: In depth consultation has taken place with the police and partners including an online survey, various meetings, discussions at the Strategic Planning Day, CSP forums, and via email around the questions being asked, methodology options, and content of the resulting data/report. We feel confident that all relevant partners have been involved and updated as progress has been made and all are satisfied with the proposal and keen to get the survey started again.
7.9	After careful consideration into the different options (full paper attached) we would like to suggest the replacement survey continues to be a paper version, sent out on a monthly basis (but only analysed quarterly), to a similar number of households with the questions changing to those which have been discussed and agreed with partners (draft questionnaire attached). The research team will be looking into efficiencies around printing and analysis over the next 2 weeks so the cost may reduce, however we feel that the most important consideration must be whether we are using the survey to get the most out of it for ourselves and partners rather than saving money. Further detail is provided below into the reasons for these decisions with the wider options being covered in the attached paper.
