


<b>Title/Subject:</b> Development of Third Sector Networks to Support Delivery of Police and Crime Plan
<b>Reference:</b>
<b>Executive Summary:</b> The decision concerns the outcome of the grant opportunity using the funding allocated from the Community Safety Fund in 2016/17 and makes recommendations for the further development of third sector networking at district level, building what has been achieved so far.
<b>Requested Decision:</b> That Voluntary Action Leeds, receive the grant of £4970 available for this year from the Community Safety Fund;  That the 4 other bids from CNET (Bradford), NBF (Calderdale), Third Sector Leaders (Kirklees) and NOVA (Wakefield) be supported from the PEG Innovation Fund for the same amount.  That the commitment is for two years, 2016 - 2018, at the same level of funding, subject to evidence of satisfactory performance and available finance.
