Thank you for your requests for information of 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> February. You requested:

- 1. How many times in 2016 your respective police forces attended 'illegal hunts using dogs'.
- 2. How many arrests, charges, cautions and prosecutions were made by your respective police forces? Could this information be sorted into pro-hunt and anti-hunt cases please?
- 3. How many complaints were made to your respective police forces alleging assault and intimidation and by whom (pro-hunt/anti-hunt)?
- 4. How many of the complaints from 3 above resulted in your police officers 'refusing' to take the correct and appropriate action?
- 5. What is your official policy on policing 'illegal hunts using dogs'?
- 6. What is the official policy of the PCC on their individual police forces FAILING to police illegal hunts properly and take appropriate action when informed of and presented with evidence of assault and intimidation?
- 7. If the PCC does not hold the information requested in my original email, does it hold ANY information on ANY subject relating to the performance of their individual forces? May I have the details of the type of information held.

I am afraid the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) does not hold the information that you have requested in questions 1-6. The Chief Constable has operational responsibility for West Yorkshire Police and also has responsibility for dealing with complaints and conduct matters for officers and staff in the Force.
