

Further to your request for information, below, I am attaching a link to the draft statement of accounts for the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

From this you can see, on page 68, that 2 individuals (including the Police and Crime Commissioner) were paid over £100,000 per year including employer's pension contributions and no-one in the Police and Crime Commissioner's Office received over £150,000.

This response is made with respect to information relating to the Police and Crime Commissioner and the staff who are employed in the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. Requests for information about payments to staff in West Yorkshire Police should be addressed to the Force.

I can confirm that no other person, in the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, has received remuneration (including pension contributions) in excess of £100,000 other than the Chief Executive and Police and Crime Commissioner.
