





Title/Subject: Reinstatement of OPCC's communications protocol
Serial No: DP0188
Summary: Agreement to extend the OPCC's communications protocol for 12 months in respect of a member of the public
Requested Decision: The existing communications protocol – which was put place in line with the OPCC's Unreasonable Behaviour and Persistent Complainers policy – expires 19 December 2020. This policy was updated April 2020 and is now called the Unreasonable Behaviour policy. Reinstating the existing protocol – which remains an option under the updated policy - allows the OPCC to continue to consistently and appropriately manage the ongoing contact. A decision is sought to reinstate the protocol for a further 12 months at which point it will be reviewed again.
