


Title/Subject: Funding for National Anti-Trafficking and Modern Slavery Network Coordinator post.
Serial No: DP0185
Summary: The post of Coordinator of the National Anti-Trafficking and Modern Slavery Network (NATMSN) has become an essential position in supporting the work of the West Yorkshire PCC in tackling human trafficking and modern slavery locally, regionally and nationally. Human trafficking and modern slavery are a priority in the West Yorkshire Police and Crime Plan and the PCC is chair of the NATMSN and West Yorkshire Anti-Slavery Partnership (WYASP). To build on the achievements of this network and partnership and to continue their purpose in providing a strategic meeting framework nationally and locally, to raise awareness of and to tackle human trafficking and modern slavery in all its forms, and support the delivery of the Police and Crime plan outcomes, the post of NATMSN Coordinator requires an extension of funding until 2022.
Requested Decision: The West Yorkshire Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner agrees to extend funding of the post of National Anti-Trafficking and Modern Slavery Network Coordinator for one year until 30th June 2022.
