

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO: 35-21

I write in connection with your request for information which was received by the Office of the Police & Crime Commissioner on 23rd April, 2021. You requested the following information:

I'd be grateful if you could let me know by return of email whether the PCC received any benefits-in-kind as part of the role in the 2019-20 year, and if so what they were worth and whether provision of a car was part of this.

The Police & Crime Commissioner does not receive any benefits in kind.
